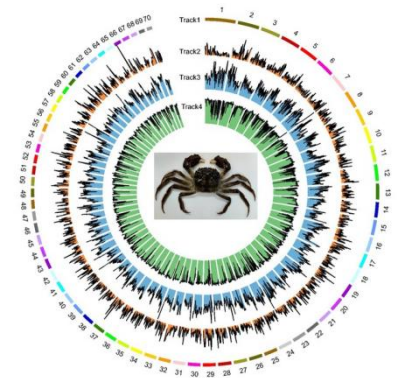
Brief Introduction to Colleges

1. College of Fisheries and Life Science

Discipline: Aquaculture, Biology(Hydrobiology)

Language of Teaching: English

College of Fisheries and Life Science has a 100-year history of education, research and training. It has more than 160 faculty members, counting the largest part of SHOU. During the past 5 years, more than 2000 research papers have been published, around 280 patents have been authorized and 2 National standards in aquaculture have been formulated.



- **Aquaculture** aims at the sustainable use of economically important aquatic animals and plants. In this discipline, biology, physiology, genetics and ecology are studied with the focus on the regular pattern of growth, development, reproduction and their relationship with environment, in order to protect and sustainable utilization of aquatic resources. Moreover, theories and operations relevant to nutritional requirements, disease prevention and control, reproduction and genetic improvement, water environment regulation & remediation, aquaculture engineering are also covered.



- **Biology** focuses on biodiversity and vital processes of aquatic organisms, such as classification, structure and function of water ecosystems. Biology

has theoretical and practical knowledge to understand phenomena and vital processes of life, managing, developing and utilizing hydrobiological resource as well as saving endangered species and maintaining balance of water ecosystem. This program also focuses on research regarding aquatic biodiversity and resource utilization, physiology and development biology in aquatic animals, aquatic ecology and conservation biology, genetic breeding and marine biological technology.

2. College of Marine Living Resource Sciences and Management

Discipline: Fishing Science, Fishery Resources, Marine Science

Language of Teaching: English

College of Marine Living Resource Sciences and Management has a national-level teaching faculty team, who serves as the Chinese chief scientist of eight International Fisheries Management Organizations. In the past five years, the college's researchers have undertaken more than 10 major projects of National Key Research & Development plans, more than 50 major projects of National Natural Science Foundation of China, and more than 200 Provincial and Ministerial Projects. The Annual Scientific Research Funding is over 100 million Yuan.

- **Fishery Resources** is to study fishery biology, fishery population dynamics and fishery resource management regime and measurements, as well as theoretical basis for sustainable exploitation and utilization, management and conservation of fishery resources.
- **Fishing Science** is to study ecological fishing gear and methods design and the suitable knowledge of the technical support for sustainable development of marine fishery.
- **Marine Science** mainly studies the nature, mutual influence and laws of physical, chemical, biological and geological processes in the ocean, while focusing on the technologies for marine resource exploitation and application.

3. College of Oceanography and Ecological Science

Discipline: Marine Science

College of Oceanography and Ecological Science has a high level teaching faculty team, who serves as the Chinese chief scientist of environmental protection and ecological restoration. In the past five years, the college's researchers have undertaken more than 20 major projects of National Key Research & Development plans and projects of National Natural Science Foundation of China, and more than 50 Provincial and Ministerial Projects. The Annual Scientific Research Funding is over 20 million Yuan.

Marine Science mainly studies the nature, mutual influence and laws of physical, chemical, biological processes in the ocean, while focusing on the technologies for marine environmental protection and ecological restoration.

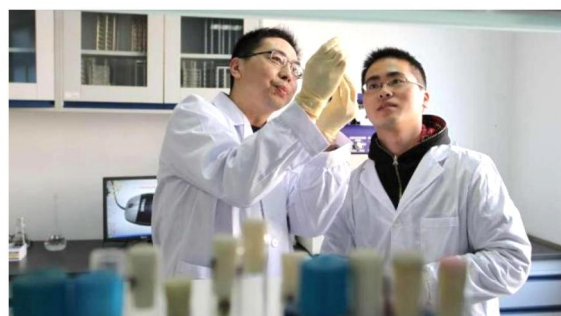


4. College of Food Sciences and Technology

Discipline: Food Science and Engineering

Language of Teaching: English

College of Food Sciences and Technology developed on the basis of the Fisheries Manufacturing Department of Wusong Fisheries School established in 1912 and now has 7 provincial and ministerial scientific research platforms. In 2015, the Food Science and Engineering Experiment Center was rated



as a national experimental teaching demonstration center. The discipline of food science and engineering was approved as a key discipline of the Ministry of Agriculture in 1998, a Shanghai characteristic key discipline in 2005, a key discipline of Shanghai Municipal Education Commission in 2009 and a first-class discipline of Shanghai's universities in 2012.

- **Food Science and Engineering** studies high-quality processing and utilization of aquatic products, food quality and safety risk assessment, food cold chain logistics and quality control, new technology of food processing engineering, food nutrition and health, etc.



5. College of Economics and Management

Discipline: Fishery Economics and Management

Language of Teaching: English

College of Economics and Management has an experimental center and three research centers, including the “Strategic Research and Development Center of China Fisheries”, the “Strategic Research and Development Center



of Marine Industry” and the “Shanghai Social Survey Center/Shanghai Ocean University Branch”. It currently has over 100 Faculty and Staff, of which 44 Faculty members have senior professional titles. 3 Senior Professors have obtained the position as leading scientist in the National Modern Agricultural Economy Technology System.

- **Fishery Economics and Management** is an important interdisciplinary subject of applied economics and fisheries science. The main research fields of this discipline are fishery economic theory and policy, fishery resources and environmental economics, market and trade of aquatic products. **Fishery economic theory and policy** mainly studies fishery production factors and technological progress, fishery microeconomic organization, fishery industrial structure, fishery support and protection, fishery modernization and sustainable development. **Fishery resources and environmental economics** mainly studies the basic theory of fishery resources and environmental economics, the optimal allocation of fishery resources, fishery resources sustainable utilization, fishery resources utilization system and environmental protection policy. **Market and trade of aquatic products** mainly studies the demand and supply of aquatic products, international trade rules and barriers, international competitiveness of aquatic products, aquatic products trade of major countries.

6. College of Engineering Science and Technology

Discipline: Marine Science

Language of Teaching: English

College of Engineering Science and Technology meets the talents needs of industries in Lin-gang Special Area, China (Shanghai) Pilot-free Trade Zone the Lingang area and focuses on the development of three directions: ship and ocean engineering, marine renewable energy, and marine and fishery engineering; The college has a provincial and ministerial level platform of Shanghai Marine Renewable Energy Engineering Technology Research Center, as well as three university level discipline platforms: Fishery Energy Conservation Research Institute, Marine Engineering Research Institute, and Marine Corrosion Protection Engineering Technology Research Center. It also has a certificate for fishery ship design issued by the Ministry of Agriculture,

as well as teaching and research software for modern design and system modeling and simulation.

- **Marine Science** studies skills and information processing technologies of modern marine exploration technologies such as marine engineering and marine information, and is able to engage in scientific research and industry fields such as marine engineering technology research, large and complex marine engineering equipment design, marine engineering surveying and mapping, marine information product development and service. The main research directions of the degree program include smart ocean, deep-sea engineering, new marine energy, design and construction of offshore functional platforms and equipment.



Scholarships in 2025

As one of the China's leading universities and a member of the National "Double First-Class initiative" universities, SHOU regularly accepts international students who have been awarded Chinese Government Scholarship (CSC) or the Shanghai Government Scholarship (SGS). Additionally, SHOU provides its own "University President Scholarship" (SHOU-PS) to attract excellent international students.

1. CSC- Chinese Government Scholarship

China Scholarship Council (CSC), offered by the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, is responsible for the enrollment and the administration of Chinese Government Scholarship programs. CSC covers tuition, expenses for accommodation, medical insurance, and stipend during the corresponding study period.

(1) CSC Scholarship Type A (Bilateral Program):

Applicants shall directly apply to the designated institutions / Chinese Embassy in your country with their agency code and visit <https://www.campuschina.org/> for more information and

Pre-Admission Letter for the assistance of scholarship application could be applied at SHOU (www.gjxssqxt.cn).

(2) CSC Scholarship Type B (Chinese University Program Scholarship):

Applicants shall apply both at SHOU (www.gjxssqxt.cn) and at CSC (<https://www.campuschina.org/>). After selection process, SHOU will shortlist the candidates, give the candidate with the Pre-Admission Letter and recommend the selected candidates to CSC council. The CSC council will review the application materials and issue the final scholarship result.

2. SGS - Shanghai Government Scholarship Type A

SGS Type A covers tuition, expenses for accommodation, medical insurance, and stipend during the corresponding study period. Applicants shall apply at SHOU (www.gjxssqxt.cn).

3. SHOU - PS: Shanghai Ocean University President Scholarship Type A

SHOU - PS Type A covers tuition, expenses for accommodation, medical insurance, and stipend during the corresponding study period. Applicants shall apply at SHOU (www.gjssqxt.cn).

Note: All the scholarship recipients must attend the Scholarship Annual Review. If one does not pass the review, the scholarship will be suspended or canceled.

Application

1. Applicant Eligibility

- (1) Non-Chinese citizen in good health, hold personal passport.
- (2) Master degree holder and no more than 30 years old.
- (3) Outstanding in academic performance GPA above 3.0 with research experience and achievements, at least has published 1 paper.
- (4) Be able to interview online. We will contact student via online method. Students are required to attend interviews and necessary communication with professors. Students who are not well equipped with necessary online learning facilities such as laptop, stable internet connection, quiet learning space etc., are not suggested to apply.
- (5) Abide by local laws, university rules and regulations.
- (6) Agree to study according to academic requirements, such as HSK 3 certificate and publishing SCI papers as graduation requirements.

2. Application Deadline: February 1st 2025

3. Application Procedures

Step 1: Check the Ph.D supervisor list, select the potential supervisor and contact to get the Supervision Confirmation Letter. Discuss with your supervisor about your research proposal at SHOU and finish the research proposal with supervisor's consent.

Step 2: Register at www.gjxssqxt.cn, complete the application form online and submit all required application documents. CSC scholarship applicants should also register and submit the application form on CSC scholarship websites above respectively.

Step 3: Pay application fee of RMB 400 by transfer or online. The application fee is non-refundable if paid.

Step 4: Participate in online interview as request.

Step 5: Track your application status and confirm the admission result.

Documents Required

1. Passport photocopy

- A clear copy of your valid passport with name, photo, date of birth, place of birth, date of issue, and date of expiry clearly visible.
- Visa page is required for applicants who are currently living outside their own country of residence.

2. 1-inch electronic personal photo(JPG format)

3. Degree certificate and transcripts of previous education

- Bachelor degree diploma, master degree diploma, and all years' transcripts.
- The photocopies of the original certificate should have the school's official stamp and/or the signature of the principal. If the original ones are not in Chinese or English, they must be translated and notarized by authorized

institution.

- Graduating students can provide the photocopies of pending graduation certificate and up-to-date transcripts. The official graduation diploma and transcripts of all years must be submitted promptly after being received.
- Original certificates must be provided on registration day.

4. Language Proficiency Certificate

- Applying for English-taught degree programs, please provide certificate of IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL IBT 80 or above received within the last 2 years. Students submitting any other English proficiency certificate may be required to provide supplementary materials.
- Applicants whose native language is English do not need to provide English language certificate.

5. Research Proposal and Study Plan

Written in English or Chinese, including Research Objectives, Methodology, Research Achievements thus far (e.g. title and abstracts of graduation thesis or published paper, list of projects), Cognition of China, Reasons for choosing SHOU, Study Objectives, Academic Goals, Future Research and Career Plan during the program.

SHOU supervisor's signature is needed on the research proposal for application submission.

Applicants are required to write the research proposal after discussion with the potential supervisor at SHOU.

6. Self-Introduction Video (MP4 Format, less than 40M)

Please provide a 3-minute self-introduction video in English. Self-introduction video may include previous academic background, reasons for choosing to study in SHOU, research plan, interests and hobbies, etc.

7. Resume

Written in English or Chinese, including your personal information, educational background, work experience, publication list, achievements so far and other information that might be useful for your application.

8. Two Recommendation Letters

Written in English or Chinese by 2 different scholars who hold the title of associate professor or higher in a related academic field. One recommender should be applicant's previous supervisor. The issue date of the recommendation letter should be later than September 1st, 2024. Recommendation letter should include the title, place of work, contact phone number, email address and written signature.

9. Statement of Financial Support

The statement can be Bank Deposit Statement or Financial Statement. It should be completed by the applicant and his/her sponsor to prove the applicant have enough financial resources to study in China.

10. Foreigner Physical Examination Certificate (Valid in 6 months)

Applicants should strictly follow the requirements of the *Physical Examination Record for Foreigner* and provide a detailed report of blood examination etc. Incomplete records, those without the signature of the doctor or official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid.

11. Non-Criminal Record

Notarized Chinese or English translation is required for non-Chinese or English versions' documents.

Entry and Visa Information

Students accepted by SHOU will receive an Admission Email which includes Admission Notice, Link to download Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201 or JW202). All documents will be in electronic version. No hardcopy will be sent to students. With these documents, students must apply for X-Type Chinese Visa (Study Visa) at their local Chinese embassy or consulate. The students are required to study at Shanghai offline in September 2025. No deferment is allowed for new students.

Accommodation

Doctoral candidates will be arranged to live in dormitory room of International Student Apartments on campus. A public common area including a study lounge, activity room, as well as laundry rooms are located on the first floor. All rooms are equipped with in-suite bathroom, shower facility, air conditioner, bed, desk, wardrobe, and other basic necessities.

中国政府奖学金来华留学管理信息系统操作流程

-适用于申请人

申请人开始奖学金申请前，请仔细阅读以下操作流程。

第 1 步：访问“留学中国”网站，点击“中国政府奖学金来华留学管理信息系统”图标进入申请系统。“留学中国”网站链接：<http://www.campuschina.org> 点击【学生注册】按钮，注册账户。注册成功后，使用注册的账户登录系统。

第 2 步：录入申请人“个人资料”。点击【编辑个人资料】开始录入个人资料，逐项完成个人资料的录入，并验证保存。完成个人资料录入后，点击【完成】返回上一界面，开始录入个人申请信息。申请人须在完成个人资料录入后，方可开始填写申请信息。

第 3 步：选择正确的“留学项目种类”。请选
择“**B类**”留学项目种类，点击【新增申请】按钮，开始录入申请信息。

第 4 步：填写正确的“受理机构编号（拟申请的高校提供）”。您的
受理机构编号为：**10264 上海海洋大学**
“留学项目种类”和“受理机构编号”两者彼此关联，均为“中国政府奖学金来华留学管理信息系统”中的必填内容。申请人填写后，系统会自动显示所填写的代码代表的受理部门的名称。留学项目种类和受理机构编号存在对应关系，如果填写错误，奖学金受理部门将无法收到在线申请信息。

第 5 步：填写“申请信息”。

完成上述操作后，录入“语言能力及学习计划”并上传“补充材料”，直至点击【提交】完成申请。

提交申请前请仔细检查各项信息及补充材料，请确保信息及材料的正确性、真实性。

“B类申请”的申请人最多可向三个志愿院校提交奖学金申请，须对应填写三所高校的“受理机构编号”，但此类学生实际仅可作为一所高校的奖学金候选人，由三所高校提交推荐时间确定。建议申请人仅填写获得预录取的一所高校，保证后续录取的成功率。

第 6 步：申请一经提交，申请人将无法修改“个人资料”及“申请信息”。申请被受理前，申请人可通过点击【撤销】撤回已提交申请，并进行修改。申请被撤回后，申请人须在编辑后再次提交，否则该申请将无法被受理。申请被受理后，申请人将无法撤回该申请。

第 7 步： 点击“打印申请”下载申请表。

第 8 步： 按照受理机构要求提交奖学金申请。

奖学金院校不得委托任何个人或中介代为受理中国政府奖学金申请，请高校提醒申请人通过国家留学基金管理委员会官方网站获取有关信息，

Instructions for Chinese Government Scholarship Information System (CGSIS)

-For Applicants

Please carefully read the instructions before applying for the scholarship.

Step 1: Visit “CSC Study in China” website and click “Scholarship Application for Students” at <http://www.campuschina.org>

Register an account through [CREATE AN ACCOUNT] and log in with your account.

Step 2: Input Personal Details. Click “Edit Personal Details” and finish inputting personal details by filling in all the information, verifying and saving the information. After the completion of this section, return to the previous page by clicking “Finish” and start filling in your application information.

Step 3: Select the correct “Program Category” .
Please select Program Category “**Type B**”, click “New Application”, and start filling in the application information.

Step 4: Input the correct “Agency Number (provided by the preferred designated university)” .

Your Agency Number is: **10264 Shanghai Ocean University**

Program Category and **Agency Number** are directly matched, both are mandatory for online application.

After inputting the agency number, the matched agency name will automatically show on the page. As **Program Category** and **Agency Number** are directly matched, application processing authorities will not receive your online application if the program category or agency number is not correct.

Step 5: Input Application Information

Next, please move on to the section of “Language Proficiency and Study Plan” and upload “Supporting Documents” as requested, then click “Submit” to complete the application. Check each part of your application carefully before submission. Please make sure that all the information and uploaded documents are valid and accurate.

“Type B” applicants can apply for the scholarship program of three desired universities by providing their respective “Agency Number”. However, they, in practice, can only

be the scholarship candidates of one of these institutions, which is determined by the time when universities submit their recommendation letters. Applicants are advised to fill in the university that has offered a pre-admission letter to increase the chances of getting admitted.

Step 6: Once submitted, amendments cannot be made on “Personal Details” and “Application Information”. Before the application is processed by the processing authorities, applicants can revoke the submitted application by clicking “Withdraw” and edit the application. After revoking the application, applicants must submit it again after re-editing, or the application will not be processed. Once the application is processed, the application cannot be revoked.

Step 7: Click “Print the Application Form” and download the form.

Step 8: Submit scholarship application under the requirements of the dispatching authorities (or application processing agency).

Scholarship-awarded universities shall not entrust any individual or intermediary agent to process Chinese Government Scholarship applications. All designated institutions shall inform applicants of accessing relevant information on the official website of the China Scholarship Council (<http://www.campuschina.org/>).

申请条件

1. 非中国籍公民, 身心健康。

2. 年龄、学历、语言要求:

● 申请攻读硕士学位者, 应当具有学士学位或同等学力, 学习成绩优秀, 年龄一般最晚不超过30周岁;

● 申请攻读博士学位者, 应当具有硕士学位或同等学力, 学习成绩优秀, 年龄一般最晚不超过35周岁;

● 申请以中文为专业教学语言的攻读硕士、博士学位者, 中文水平须达到汉语水平考试 (HSK) 五级;

● 申请人应当同时符合所申请学校在学术能力、语言能力及其它相关方面的入学要求。

申请材料

1. 《中国政府奖学金申请表》(中文或英文填写)。

2. 护照首页。如现持有护照有效期不符合要求(护照有效期应晚于2026年3月), 请及时换发新护照。

3. 经公证的所有学历证明。申请博士需提供本科和硕士学历证明。申请硕士需提供本科学历证明。如申请人为在校学生, 须提交本人就读学校出具的预计毕业证明或在学证明。

4. 学习成绩单(自本科阶段起)。成绩单扫描件应包括本科、硕士(如有)、博士(如有)学习阶段, 直至最近一学期的成绩。成绩单应由就读学校教务处、研究生院或有关学生管理部门开具并盖章。可提供中/英文成绩单, 如为英语以外语种, 需另提供英文翻译件并公证。

5. 语言能力证明。申请以中文为专业教学语言的申请人须提供有效期内且与相应中文水平要求相符的HSK成绩报告。申请以外语为专业教学语言的申请人应根据学校要求提供相应的语言能力证明, 如雅思或托福成绩单。

6. 预录取材料。

(1) 拟来华就读院校出具的预录取材料, 可为正式录取通知书、预录取通知

书或经中国高校国际学生招生部门认可的导师邀请函等。预录取通知或正式邀请信应使用中方院校专用信纸打印，由国内高校国际学生招生录取有关部门出具，须加盖公章。

(2) 入学通知/邀请信中应包含以下内容（中/英文）

- a. 申请人基本信息：申请人姓名、国籍、出生日期、上一学历院校名称等；
- b. 来华学习身份：硕士研究生/博士研究生；
- c. 预计来华时间：应明确起止年月，入学时间应不早于 2025 年 9 月；
- d. 申请人中国高校导师（如有）信息；
- e. 申请人来华学习/研究工作描述；
- f. 授课语言（中文或外文）；

g. 如为导师出具的邀请信，须有国际学生招生部门负责人签字与联系方式，并加盖公章；

7. **来华研究/学习计划**。应提交中/英文学习计划（1000 字以上。为评审的核心材料。除专业研究内容外，还可包括来华学习的意愿，对中国的认知，对学校的认知，学业背景，专业背景，专业能力，未来的规划），**须由中方导师签字**，学习计划只可以用中文或者英文书写。

8. 推荐信。提交两名教授或副教授的推荐信，内容应重点包含对申请人来华学习目标要求，中方院校或者中方导师与国外导师的合作情况或者校际交流情况，以及对综合能力，未来发展的评价，只可用中文或英文书写。

9. **个人作品**。申请攻读艺术、设计类专业者，可通过“作品/其他支撑材料”上传个人作品类材料（如影像、绘画作品等），亦可按照申请院校要求以其他方式提供。建议上传已发表的文章，如有已接受但在审核中的，请上传相关凭证。

10. 年龄不满 18 周岁的申请人，须提交在华法定监护人的相关法律文件。

11. 《外国人体格检查表》复印件（原件自行保存，此表格由中国卫生检疫部门统一印制，须英文填写）。申请人应严格按照《外国人体格检查表》中要求的项目进行检查。缺项、未贴有本人照片或照片上未盖骑缝章、无医师和医院签字盖章的《外国人体格检查表》无效，检查结果有效期为 6 个月。

12. 无犯罪记录证明。申请人须提交由所在地公安机关出具的有效期限内的无犯罪记录证明，通常应为提交申请之日前 6 个月以内的证明文件。若申请截止日期前无法提供，请签署无犯罪记录承诺书，并必须在报到前完成无犯罪记录证明提交。

注意：通过系统上传的材料须清晰、真实、有效。建议申请人使用专业设备扫描需提交的有关文件，因材料不清晰或无法可识别造成的后果由申请人承担。

Chinese Government Scholarship Application Documents

Applicants of Chinese Government Scholarship can find more information about the scholarship scheme, such as introduction to designated universities and their scholarship programs and the process of filing an application, on the website www.campuschina.org.

Eligibility: To be eligible, applicants must

- be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health both mentally and physically.
- be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 30 when applying for master's programs;
- be a master's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for doctoral programs;
- have acquired the Chinese proficiency of HSK Level 5 when applying for Chinese-taught master's or doctoral programs;
- meet the admission requirements of the applied universities in terms of academic ability, language proficiency and other relevant criteria.

Application Documents

1. Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship (in Chinese or English);
2. Copy of Passport Home Page. If the validity of the applicant's current passport does not meet the requirement (meaning the passport expires before March 2026), please apply for a new passport before submitting the application;
3. Notarized all degree diplomas. Doctoral program candidates need to provide bachelor and master degree diplomas. Master program candidates need to provide bachelor degree diplomas. Prospective diploma winners must submit official proof of student status by their current school. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations;
4. Academic transcripts (from the undergraduate program onwards). Copies of academic records from first to last semester during the undergraduate, graduate (if any), and doctoral programs (if any) shall be provided. These transcripts shall be issued and sealed by the attending university's academic affairs office, graduate school, or student management department. They can be in Chinese or English, but must be attached with notarized English translations if they are in foreign languages other than English;
5. Language qualification certificates. Applicants for Chinese-taught programs must submit valid HSK reports in accordance with the corresponding Chinese proficiency requirements. Applicants for other language-taught programs shall provide relevant language proficiency certificates according to the universities' requirements, like IELTS or TOFEL report;
6. Pre-admission documents.
 - (1) Pre-admission documents issued by the Chinese university of preference, including an official admission letter, a pre-admission letter, or an invitation letter from a prospective supervisor recognized by the department of international students admission

at Chinese universities. The pre-admission letter or official invitation letter shall be printed on the special-purpose letter of the desired Chinese university and issued and sealed by the university's international students admission office;

(2) The enrollment letter or invitation letter shall contain the following information (in Chinese or English):

- a. Applicant information: full name, nationality, date of birth, name of the university last attended, and others;
 - b. Academic status in China: graduate student or doctoral student;
 - c. Projected time of staying in China. The study timeline shall be made clear, and the time of enrollment shall be no earlier than September 2025;
 - d. Information of the applicant's Chinese supervisor (if any);
 - e. Descriptions of the applicant's studies or research in China;
 - f. Language taught in courses (Chinese or English);
 - g. The supervisor-issued invitation letter shall be sealed by the department of international students admission and accompanied by the signature and contact information of the head of the department.
7. **A study plan research proposal.** A study plan written in Chinese or English shall contain more than 1,000 characters or words; Guide on Research Proposal/Study plan: Research Proposal on your PhD study plan [most important on the professional research plan which shows your research goal and ability]. Also need to include willingness to study in China, cognition of China, cognition of school, academic background, professional background, introduction to professional ability, future plans in professional fields, future development plans, etc.
- The proposal of the student shall be signed by the applicant's Chinese supervisor;**
8. Recommendation letters. Two letters of recommendation (written only in Chinese or English) from professors or associate professors shall be submitted. These letters shall describe the applicant's objectives of learning in China, comprehensive abilities, and evaluation of future growth, as well as the cooperation between the supervisors or the exchange between universities both in China and abroad;
9. **Example of art.** To apply for majors related to art or design, applicants could submit their own works through "Example of Art/Other Supporting Documents" in the system. Applicants could also provide such materials to the applied universities directly in other ways; **[Suggest upload your publication. If is under review, please upload related receipt or proof to enhance your capability in general]**
10. Applicants under the age of 18 should submit the valid documents of their legal guardians in China;
11. A photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form completed in English (the original copy shall be kept by the applicant). The form is designed by the Chinese quarantine authority and can be obtained from the dispatching authority. The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician,

the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. Please select the appropriate time to take a physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months.

12. Non-criminal record report. The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months prior to the submission date of the application. If the applicant cannot provide it before the application deadline, please sign the Non-criminal Record Affirmation and must the criminal record before registration.

Reminder: Uploaded supporting documents must be clear, authentic and valid. Applicants are recommended to use a professional device to scan the relevant documents. Applicants shall bear the consequences caused by unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials.
